Returning to the room where, 50 years ago, he came to La MaMa with the ETC Company of La MaMa, Don Arrington, with Louisa Bradshaw and Camille Tibaldeo sings sixty years of eclectic Arrington music, Peter Dizozza on keyboards, Greg Bufford, percussion.

Don Arrington (Music/Lyrics, Performer, Director) Coming to La MaMa in 1970, Don has been a fixture of Downtown theater ever since, working, in this room, as an actor and singer with Will Leach and John Braswell's ETC Company of La MaMa and with John Vaccaro in the Playhouse of the Ridiculous at La MaMa and at Theater for the New City. He has performed at numerous regional theatres and at The Delacorte Theater with The New York Shakespeare Festival and has appeared in the works of William M. Hoffman, Rosalyn Drexler, Liz Swados and Ken Bernard, among others. As a composer and playwright he has written scores of tunes and incidental music for Downtown theater, including Vaccaro's Juba. He is known, in addition to other works, for his musical, Allegros!, musical revues If This Ain't It!, On the Block, dance theater piece, Without Apparent Motive, and, with librettist Stephan Holt, the one woman opera, I Love My Voice. He is currently preparing for production of his new full length play with music, Cemetery Beach," and his ballet. Dance on a Blue Sea.

Camille Tibaldeo (Performer) performed in repertory with the ETC Company of La MaMa under the direction of Wilford Leach and John Braswell in New York City and on European and U.S. tours, and in revivals of the ETC signature work *Carmilla* including its 30th Anniversary run directed by Ellen Stewart. She has appeared in productions directed or produced by Michael Bennett, María Irene Fornés, Tom O'Horgan, and John Vaccaro, as well as in regional theater and cabaret throughout the Northeast. Camille has had the pleasure of performing in numerous original musical theater pieces created by fellow ETC member Don Arrington at La MaMa and Theater for the New City, and with Don in *Back Again*: *On the Block*, a two-person show of his works at the club Pangea.

Louisa Bradshaw (Performer) has worked as an actress, a singer and a songwriter in premiere venues and theatres in Berlin and New York City. She has had the pleasure of working with some of the great ones which are too long to list. Suffice it to say Don Arrington is at the top of her list with his beautiful songs and theatrical TALENT! She is thrilled to be working with Don and Camille who are both founding members of the legendary La MaMa ETC Company. Oh, the energy in this place tonight!!!

Peter Dizozza (Keyboards) is a playwright, composer, pianist, music director, performer and visual artist. Peter is the composer for the TNC summer Street Theater touring the city parks, recipient of the New York Foundation for the Arts City Artists Corps grant to produce a staged reading of the project (concept, script and score), *Tunnel* (From Suez to Candlewood). His current original project, its sequel, is called *Mushroom Head*. The musical plays by Peter Dizozza in the La MaMa Archive are *Prepare to Meet Your Maker*, *The Peace Mission*, *Witchfinders*, *Coppelia*, *The Eleventh Hour*, *The Last Dodo*, *The Golf Wars*, *Tentagatnet*, *O*, A *Question of Solitude* and *The New Floater Family* (Act II of Float). Music only: *Convertible* and *Chasing Heaven*. Cinema VII administers his creative catalog.

Greg Bufford (Percussion) is a drummer, composer, producer and educator studied music at Berklee College of Music, Rutgers University and with master Jazz drummer Philly Joe Jones. Greg Bufford worked as a professional musician internationally with such artist as Dee Dee Bridgewater, Freda Payne, Dakota Staton, Leslie Uggams, Melba Moore, Freddie Cole, Dion Warwick, Little Jimmy Scott, Randy Weston, Sonny Stitt, Madonna/Sandra Bernhart Duo. As a Composer/Producer Greg has written music for Film And T.V. his credits include Sesame Street, Roll Bounce, South Central, and is credited for the 1979 Classic Gold Recording Bounce, Rock, Shake, Roll. Greg Bufford is the Founder of the Bufford School Of Music.

Donald Eastman (Visual Consultant) Collaborators at La MaMa include playwright/directors Tom Eyen, Mike Gorman, Theodora Skipitares and Winston Tong. Donald received an OBIE Award for Sustained Excellence and is Resident Designer at La MaMa.

Gloria Gomez (Stage Manager) (she/her) is a technician/ stage manager at La MaMa and is happy to be returning to work on *Had Enuf of the Blues*. Previous stage management credits include *Can I Be Frank?*, *La MaMa SQUIRTS 2024*, and *La MaMa Puppet Slam 2024*. Other stage management credits include the 2025 Out FRONT! Festival presented by Pioneers Go East Collective in partnership with BAM and Judson Church. She is also an aspiring sound designer creating electronic music compositions for independent projects. She is a graduate of Oberlin College and an alumnus of the Trinity/La MaMa Performing Arts Program.


